

Mountain MSc scholarship

Since 2004, the UHI Millennium Institute (the future University of the Highlands and Islands in Scotland) has delivered an MSc in Managing Sustainable Mountain Development (<http://www.cms.uhi.ac.uk/msc.htm>). This is a unique course for a number of reasons: it is delivered on-line and part-time, and has a focus on sustainable development in mountain areas. Following three years of experience, the course has now been approved for delivery to anyone living in Europe.

A scholarship is available for this course for one student starting in the next academic year (from September 2008), with priority for residents of the mountains of the states that joined the EU in 2004 and 2007. The scholarship will cover all fees for the course. Candidates for the scholarship should apply in the normal way. The deadline for applications for the scholarship is 20 March. Short-listed applicants will be interviewed by phone on 15 April. The successful candidate will have to prove competence in English, and to commit to take two modules each semester (September to December and late January to May) for two years and to undertake a dissertation in the third year.
